LISTED BUILDINGS/ANCIENT MONUMENTS

1. St Mary's Church, Crosserlough, County Cavan, Ireland:

Major timber preservation works to combat woodworm and wet rot infestation.
Contractor – Conservation & Preservation Projects.
Tribor Gel, Tritec 121, Trimol 50 Rods, Trimol 36 Structural Grout.



2. Anne of Cleves House, Lewes, Sussex:

Restoration of original 15th century roof rafters to combat wet rot and death watch beetle
Contractor – Archers Specialist Treatments.
Tripaste Mayonnaise.



3. Kirkleatham Almshouses, Redcar:

Treatment of woodworm infested roof timbers
Contractor – Thorburn Preservation.
Tritec 121.



4. Dockside Warehouse, Liverpool:

Structural repair to principal rafters and tie beams at roof level, and to floor beams at all levels.
Contractor – Peter Cox Ltd.
Trimol 36, Trifix Adhesive, Trimol 54.



5. Watermens' Hall, City of London (Listed Ancient Monument):

Strengthening of original Georgian pine structural beams
Contractor – Bryhill Technical Services.
Trimol 36, Trimol 23.



6. Luxury Refurb, Maida Vale, London:

New build/retrofit basement/subterranean rooms: Habitable accommodation.
Main contractor – 800 Group Ltd.
150m Waterstop. 700m² Platon membrane. 100m Aquachannel.
700m² TT Vapour Membrane to swimming pool and green roof.



7. Bethnal Green Town Hall, London:

Refurbishment of existing basement floor.
Contractor – Ward Damp.
2000m² Triton TT Vapour membrane.



8. Belmont Chapel & Almshouses, Hereford (listed building in close proximity to landfill site):

Provision of ground gas barrier and damp proof course in almshouse redevelopment.
Contractor – R. Liddiard, R. Nicholas.
Triton TT Vapour Membrane, Triton Injection Mortar, Fillet Seal, Ground Gas Fans.



9. Plymouth Lifeboat House:

Provision of water based water repellent to protect exterior walls (Plymouth Limestone) of historic building sited on Plymouth Hoe.
Contractor – Target Treatment for Bruce Harrison Ltd.
200m² Triproof AQ.



10. LSE (old Land Registry Building) Lincolns Inn Fields:

Basement waterproofing as part of £11 million modernisation project.
Contractor – Bryhill Technical Services for main contractor Willmot Dixon.
1600m² Platon P8 Membrane, TT Vapour Membrane and TriSeal.



11. St. Thomas' Priory, Staffordshire (Scheduled Ancient Monument):

Platon cavity drain membrane system installed to walls and floors of five barn conversions as an alternative to a traditional chemical injection damp proofing system because building regulations prohibited the drilling into any of the original stone walls. For the same reason the membranes were fixed using 'Cobb' plugs, fixed into the mortar joints, instead of the usual brick plugs.
Contractor – Rudders & Paynes.
